The Atrium Gallery is managed by the VCAC to provide a wide array of visual arts from diverse artists for the community’s enjoyment and education, while coexisting within an active public workplace. Juried competitive shows are held throughout the year with the upper floor occasionally used for curated exhibitions (listed above). The VCAC usually juries submissions to competitive shows, but it secures outside Judges to select award winners. Jurying is FREE; artists only pay for work that is juried into a show. There are NO charges for work in curated exhibits. Approximately 3000 citizens and 1200 employees pass through the Gallery daily. Its three floors include some 400 linear feet of exhibit walls as well as limited room for free-standing small and large three-dimensional work. One-off “installation pieces” are welcomed; give us a proposal.
